

Camp Louemma, a residential, co-ed sleepaway camp located in Northern NJ, is seeking a Waterfront for Summer 2011 (June 22- August 8).

Current certification as American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor, Lifeguard Training, First Aid, and CPR are essential. Certified Pool Operators License a plus.

Applicant must be able to:

- Explain, uphold, and enforce all waterfront regulations.
- Train and supervise lifeguards for free swim and other non-instructional waterfront activities at both our pool and lake.
- Offer CPR and lifeguarding courses to enable staff attainment of certifications.
- Train and supervise swim instructors. Assign campers to classes and check camper skills for meeting American Red Cross level requirements.
- Maintain necessary records for camp and the American Red Cross.
- Supervise and/or approve alternate lifeguards for evening waterfront activities.
- Maintain a safe waterfront by minimizing or eliminating areas of risk.
- Monitor the maintenance needs of the waterfront and pool including regulation of pool chemistry, pump and filtration system and cleaning, testing and vacuuming of pool.
- Supervise as Head Lifeguard (or approve alternate Head Lifeguard for) daily free swim and activities. Assign guarding zones for free swim.
- Execute water emergency plan in the event of accident, injury, or missing camper.
- Schedule and supervise all waterfront/boating activities (canoeing, kayaking, and paddle boating), and maintain lakefront area, docks and boats.

Salary is negotiable. Room and board will be provided if residing in camp.
